The Allotments Committee is the key liaison mechanism between the General Committee and the Allotments Sites. Its purpose is to enable the, responsible, efficient and sustainable running of the allotments. We urge anyone who has time and skills to contribute to put themselves forward. We would particularly welcome nominations from members who could take on the role of organising rotas for various duties to maintain the common parts or who could help organise events.

You must be a current FHS Member and Allotment Holder to be elected to this Committee. Nominations require a proposer who must also be a current FHS Member and an Allotment Holder. Existing Committee members may stand for re-election, but must complete a nomination form. There are currently 6 elected places on the Committee. The Allotment Secretary has automatic voting membership; other General Committee members may attend as advisors.

Notice of the AGM, including names of those standing for election, will be sent to all Members at the beginning of March. The 2020 elections will take place at the Annual General Meeting on **Tuesday 17th March 2020** (note for your diary).
